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Narrative

On 11/21/2009 1601 hours this unit (C5B) was dispatched to 176 Capital Ave in response to a burglary complaint. Upon arrival I met with the homeowner Lynn Morris who stated that her property had been burglarized. She stated that she has been in the process of renovating the property which is vacant. Morris stated that on 11/20/2009 at 1730 hours, she secured the property and went home. When she returned to the property earlier today at 1445 hours, she discovered her garage door was open and the basement lights were turned on. Entry was made by the garage door because all the other doors and windows were secured and not damaged. Morris stated that two remote garage door openers were missing which were in the garage. She stated that she believes that the perpetrators used the garage door openers to make entry. Morris stated that yesterday was the last time she remembers seeing the two missing garage openers. Morris also stated that she keeps a spare key to the house hidden outside next to the garage door which was not taken. Inside of the basement, the perpetrator(s) removed all of the copper pipe. Morris stated that all of the copper pipe was cut using a pipe cutting tool because nothing was damaged. Morris stated that the perps even shut off the shut off main valve for the water. Morris stated that all to the cabinets were left open upstairs on the first floor but nothing was missing or damaged. Morris stated that she believes that it will cost her over two thousand dollars to repair the missing copper pips. Before departing, Morris was advised to disconnect the electric garage door and to make it so the door opens manually and not with a remote.

This officer spoke with Morris's next door neighbor Alex Mendez of 180 Capital Ave, who stated that this morning at around 0900 hours he saw a male walk behind Morris's yard. He stated that he did not get a look at him and could not describe him. stated that he did not think nothing of it because he thought it was the Morris family renovating their house.

This officer performed a neighborhood canvas with negative results. Morris was furnished with the police case number and advised that a report would be on file and forwarded to the burglary squad. I advised Morris to follow up with the burglary squad with any new information pertaining to this incident.

He then informed this officer that the last time that he saw his cousin's door in tact was last night (7/28/09) at 2000hrs. It should be noted that the basement door faces Meriden Rd, and appeared to be kicked in.</p> <p>At this time Lee took this officer through the house. Lee informed this officer that the only room that was entered was his cousin's bedroom. It is important to note that dresser drawers were opened along with the master bedrooms closet doors. Lee was unable to determine if any of his cousins belongings were missing at this time. At this time I spoke to Min over the phone.</p> <p>Min informed this officer that he will be home from vacation August 10 09, and stated he would notify the detective bureau if anything was taken from his apartment. Maintenance was on scene and fixed Min's basement door. A canvas of the area was conducted in search of witnesses with negative results. All parties were given the case number and informed that a report would be filed.</p>

DETAILS OF OFFENSE: Describe important information as to why or how the incident occurred; physical evidence; include serial numbers of property if available; vehicles used if any; any suspects; etc.

On 11/10/09 I responded to the Southford Park apartments located on National Ave. and Fillmore Street to continue a burglary investigation involving apartments in the complex. I spoke to Carabetta Apartments maintenance supervisor, Juan Perez, who reported that a resident reported to him that her apartment had been burglarized on Sunday 11/08/09. I then went with Perez to 113 Fillmore St. apt. 1, where I met the resident, *Raquel Sanchez*

Sanchez said that on 11/8/09 she left her apartment at about 1000hrs, and that all doors and windows had been locked. *Sanchez* then said that when she got home at about 2300hrs. that night, she found that a chair propped against her front door had been moved, and that her upstairs bedroom had been ransacked. *Sanchez* said that she found that only two items had been taken: a Garmin brand GPS unit, valued at \$250, and a Dell brand laptop computer, valued at \$1000. *Sanchez* said that she bought the GPS at Best Buy about a year ago, and that her husband bought the laptop from Dell over the phone. *Sanchez* said that she no longer has any paperwork for either item that has the serial numbers. She only had the A/C adaptor for the laptop with the following numbers: CN-ODF266.

Sanchez said that she was afraid to report the incident to police, but that she did report it to the leasing office. I found no sign of forced entry, and *Sanchez* had already cleaned her apartment since the incident. *Perez* said that when a new resident moves into an apartment, the locks are swapped with empty apartments from other parts of the complex. I advised *Sanchez* to contact me with any further information on the stolen items.

Miller further stated that she noticed that the drawers from her bedroom dresser were open. Miller stated that some of her clothes in the drawers were disheveled. Miller informed me that nothing appears to be stolen at this time. Miller added that she makes sure all her windows are doors are shut and locked before she leaves to go anywhere. Miller stated that she does not know who may have done this. Miller further stated she called her neighbors, but no one heard or seen anything suspicious.

I observed minor damage to the area of her door lock. The door lock appeared bent as if it was pried open with some sort of skinny metal tool. A neighborhood canvass was conducted but produced no leads.

On 6/6/09 at 1400 hrs this unit was dispatched to 172 Capital Av on a burglary complaint. Upon arrival I spoke to complainant **Matthew O'Sullivan** 12/26/72 who stated that he left his house this morning at 1000 hrs and when he return at 1400 hrs he noticed that his shed was broken into and the basement window was kicked in. He said that he checked inside his residence but found nothing missing throughout the residence and it appeared the way he left it. He checked his shed and stated that his 20 ft ladder (\$115), craftsman lawnmower (\$195), proline pool pump (\$300), portable lights (\$200), car waxer (\$50), scotts weed feeder (\$30), iTT yard light (\$350), Tower climbing harnis (\$1700), 1 snapple cooler, a silver 16 ft ladder, and wind chimes (Total Value \$2940) were missing. **O'Sullivan** said that he believes that there are more items missing but needs to check. He added that ne does not have receipts nor serial numbers for the items at this time. **O'Sullivan** did say that his friend **Andy** () called him on the phone and over heard a conversation between **Donovan** 8/16/73 and another male telling **Donovan** that **O'Sullivan's** house is being foreclosed on and all of his belongings are for the taking. **Donovan** told the male that he would take a look. **O'Sullivan** said that **Donovan** lives down the street at 65 Capital Av.

I went down to **Donovan's** house with **O'Sullivan** in an attempt to speak with him. No one was home. I checked around the residence and saw a silver ladder on the side of the garage and a red craftsman lawnmower in plain view inside the garage that was half opened. I called

over O'Sullivan who said that those were his items. O'Sullivan reclaimed his 20 ft ladder, craftsman lawnmower, proline pool pump, portable lights, car waxer, scotts weed feeder, ITT yard light, Tower climbing harnis, and the coolers.

I spoke to Andy who did not want to be involved but he did over hear the said conversation. Also he gave me a contact number for Donovan (203) 555-7722

I called and spoke to Donovan who stated that someone did tell him that O'Sullivan's items were for the taking so he went up there cleaned out the shed. Donovan said that most of the items were in his garage and he would return the rest of the items. Donovan refused to meet up with me at this time and hung up.

I did observe the damage to the basement window and the shed doors . I informed O'Sullivan that if he finds that anything else is missing and wishes to pursue this incident he should follow up with the D.B. Also if he has any other problems, he should contact the police. I advised O'Sullivan that my report will be forwarded to the D.B.

At this time, I observed the front exterior door and did find some loose wood on the door frame, where the door closes. I also observed several marks on the door near the door lock, and was unable to tell if these marks were newer or older.

I then advised *Sperry* that a report will be completed on this incident, and that it will be forwarded to the Burglary Squad for investigation. I also told *Sperry* to call the police immediately if she should need further assistance.

Narrative

On 11/07/09 at 0825 Hours this Officer was dispatched to 83 Taft Pointe Road, Apartment #2, regarding a complaint of a past burglary.

Upon my arrival, I spoke with the complainant Joseph Bell (08/13/81) of the above address. Bell said that he just returned home this morning, after having been at work all night and discovered that someone had burglarized his apartment. He said that he had left for work yesterday afternoon at 3:15PM and he had just returned home now at 8AM. Entry into his apartment was gained by prying open the front door, which had been locked with a dead-bolt lock. The wooden door jamb was cracked and the wood was splintered in the area of the dead bolt, and there was a dent on the door from a pry bar type tool. Bell also said that the perpetrator(s) had also attempted to gain entry into his apartment through the rear second floor (rear deck) kitchen window. The glass on this kitchen window was cracked but was still in place, and the window screen had two small finger size holes in it.

Bell said that the only items he could tell that were stolen from his apartment were:

- 1.) Two gold necklace chains, valued at approximately \$300 each;
- 2.) Two gold crosses, also valued at approximately \$300 each.
- 3.) Coins taken from a coffee mug which was on top of kitchen counter.

This Officer then went to speak with neighbors in this apartment building to attempt to find witnesses. This Officer learned from neighbors that around midnight last night two other apartments in this building were also burglarized. Dispatch then searched the previous calls for service, and advised me that at approximately 2330 Hours last night Officer #565, investigated burglaries at #83-3, and 83-6 Taft Pointe Road. I then advised my supervisor Sgt. #400 and Detective 570 in the D.B. regarding this third burglary. Sgt. 400 then reviewed Officer 565's reports from last night (09-7837, 09-7838) but there was no pertinent additional information available.

Bell was advised that I would complete this report and that a copy would be available at Waterbury Police Headquarters. He was advised to contact the Burglary Squad for further investigation, and that if he finds any together missing items he can respond to the Waterbury Police Detective Bureau with a list of the items so that they may be attached to this report.

Narrative

On 8/21/09 at 2110 hours I, Officer : # 768 , was dispatched to 165 National Ave Unit 4 on a burglary complaint.

When I arrived I spoke to the complainant, Ann Hudson (5/15/79) of the dispatched address, who told me someone broke into her apartment through the back door and stole her laptop. Hudson further explained that she left for work at approximately 0615 hours and returned home at 1800 hours to discover the back door to the residence was open. She looked through her apartment and found that her 13" red Dell laptop computer was missing from the top of her bedroom dresser. Hudson valued the laptop at \$600, but she was unable to provide any serial/model numbers. She stated that some dresser drawers were also opened, but nothing else appeared to be missing.

Hudson told me that both the back door and its screen door were locked when she left for work. I observed that the screen portion appeared to be cut, and the frame to the large door appeared to have pry marks. The lock catch to the frame was broken off and laying on the floor near the door. Everything else in the apartment appeared to be in order.

Hudson did not know who might have broken into her residence, but mentioned that it was burglarized approximately a month prior. She told me that there was no surveillance equipment around the apartment complex.

I spoke to Hudson's neighbor Jeane Diaz (11/12/70) of Unit 3. Diaz stated that she was home all day, but did not hear or see anyone enter the back door to Hudson's residence.

I canvassed the area but was unable to locate any suspects or witnesses. I also called the Detective Bureau to notify them of the incident.

I notified Hudson that a report would be on file and to contact the police with any further information.

Narrative

On 9/5/09 at 0000 hrs this unit, Officer 781 and Officer 721 were dispatched to 7 Taft Pointe Unit 57 on a Burglary Complaint.

Upon arrival, I Officer 781 spoke to the complainant, an Emily Flynn 11/21/38, who stated that she locked her back door this evening around 1900 hrs on 9/4/09. Flynn then stated that she noticed that her alarm light was going off and in doing so, went down stairs to check to see if the doors were still locked. After that, at around 2320 hrs Flynn stated that her back door was ajar and the chainlock on the top of the door was broken. Flynn then stated she immediately called police. 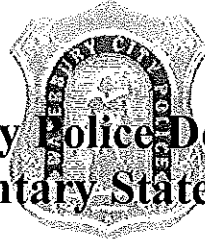

I, the undersigned, Marc Brady of 101 Taft Pointe Rd. Unit-2 Waterbury, CT,
being 27 years of age, born in Waterbury on 03/21/1982, do hereby make the following
statement to #570, having first been identified as a Waterbury Police Detective.

I voluntarily came to the Waterbury Police Department tonight to give a statement to detectives about a suspicious person I saw in my condo complex twice in the past month. I can read and write English without any problems and attended college for one year. I have not been forced to give this statement or promised anything in return.

On 10/23/09 at around 8:00 pm I was on my back deck smoking a cigarette when I saw a dark colored vehicle park just before my driveway which is on a cul-de-sac. A black male wearing a dark colored hoody got out of the passenger side of the car. He was about 5'10" and had a medium build. He was wearing dark colored jeans with white sneakers. The vehicle then turned around and parked about 30 yards away. The black male that got out of the car went to the condo complex across from mine and went to the back of the building. I know everyone who lives in the building and I didn't recognize him. I walked out to my mailbox as an excuse to try and get the plate on the car but it was too far away. I then walked to the dumpster to see if I could see what the guy was doing. From the dumpster I was able to see the guy standing on the back porch of the end unit which is 111 Unit-1. He was pulling and kicking on the slider door. The lady who lives in the unit is Megan and she wasn't home. The lights were all off and her car was gone. I walked up the porch and asked the guy what he was doing. At this point I was within five feet of him. He said he was looking for Tim and that Tim owed him money. I told the guy that nobody named Tim lived at the address and said I was calling the police. He told me to call the police and when I got on my cell phone he jumped over the railing and ran towards the car that he got out of. I chased after him and he ran towards the car he got out of earlier. He ran past the car and the car took off and he got into the car before I was able to catch up with him. I chased after the car but was unable to get a marker plate. I did see that he made a right onto Oronoke Rd. I called the police and when the officer arrived I told him what happened. While I was talking with the officer Megan came home and I went to condo with the officer. The officer told me that he found pry marks on the back slider.

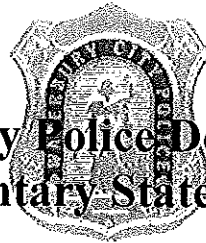

This past Friday at around 7:30 pm I went out on my back porch to have a cigarette when I saw the same black car park in the same spot as it was in October. I then saw a black male came running down the road from behind a building carrying a what looked like a white pillow case in his hand. He got into the passenger side and the vehicle took off. The male had the same build and was wearing the same clothing down to the white sneaker as the guy in October. I got into my vehicle and started going after him. I didn't see them leave Taft Pointe so I made a right onto Oronoke Rd. because that the way they went the last time. As I got to the top of Oronoke Rd I was able to see the car at the bottom of the road. They made a left at the stop sign and I continued to follow them. They ended up on Bristol St. and at the stop sign they made a right onto Platts Mill Rd. I that point I was able to get the first three numbers of the marker plate which were 315. They continued on Platts Mill Rd. and eventually made a left onto South Main St. heading back towards Waterbury. The road turned to two lanes and I was able to get close enough to get the whole plate which was 315-WER and I could see that it was a black Mitsubishi Gallant. I drove up alongside the passenger side of the Mitsubishi and got a good look at the passenger and saw that he was the same guy that I saw and talked to on Megan's porch in October. Once I got a good look at the guy and got the marker plate I backed off and drove back home. When I got home I called the police and an officer came to my house. I gave the officer the plate number and told him about what happened in October.

This morning at about 8:40 am Det. 570 came to my condo and asked me if I would mind looking at some pictures. Det. 570 handed me a sheet of paper with instructions on it for looking at photos. I read the instructions and understood them. I then initialed and signed the form showing that I understood them. Det. 570 then handed me a sheet of paper with the pictures of eight similar looking black males on it and asked me if I recognized anyone and if so from where. I immediately recognized the guy in photo # 1 as the male I saw on Megan's porch in October and the same male that I saw in the Mitsubishi last Friday. Det. 570 told me that the male in photo # 1 was Kody Minerini 2/23/74. I couldn't give a statement this morning when Det. 570 came to my house because I had to go to work so I came tonight. I have read this statement and it is the truth.
