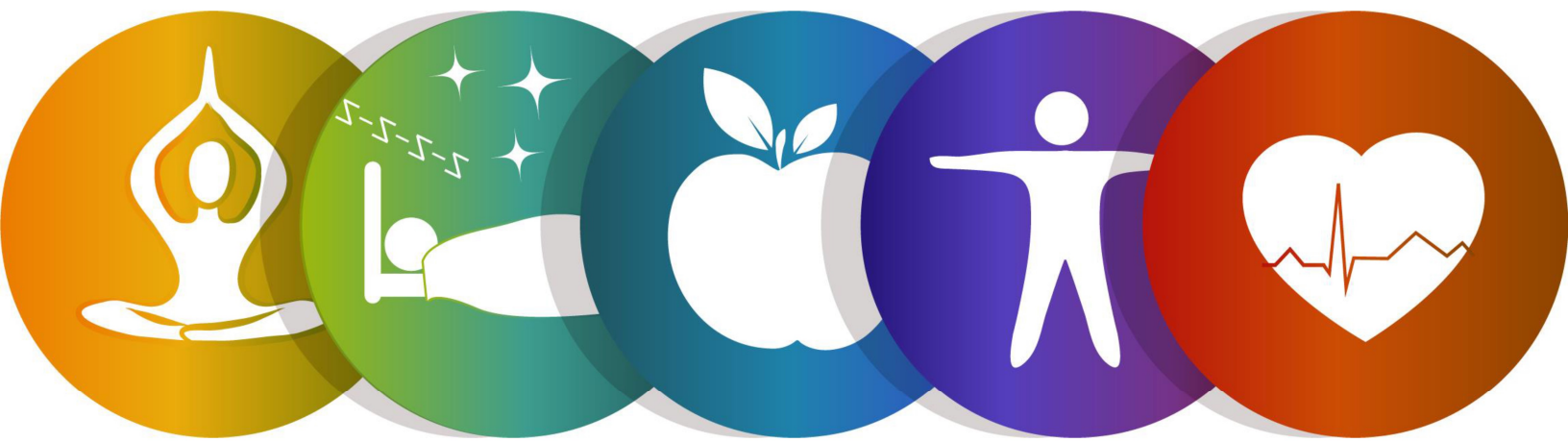


Curiosity Gap

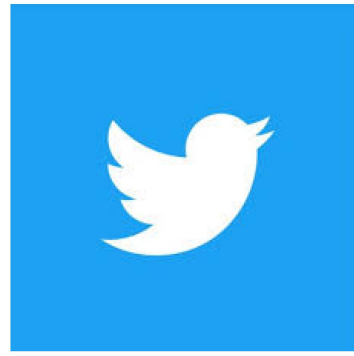

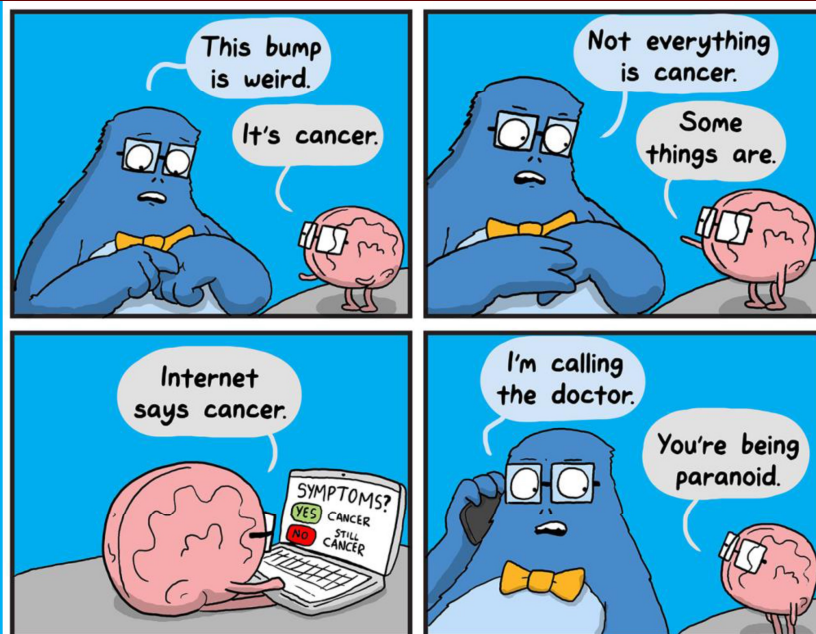

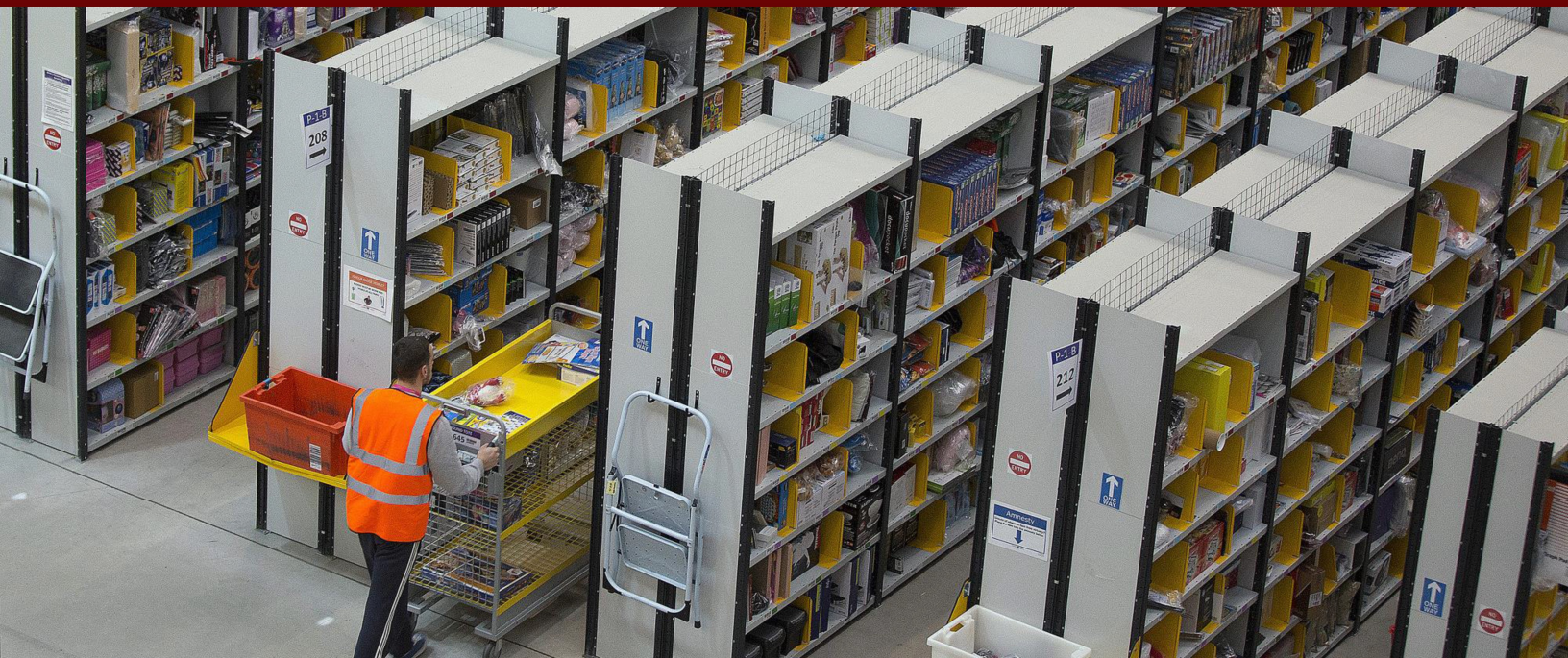
