

Exhibition Idea Sheet

Your role as an exhibition curator is to assemble or select works of art, grouped around an idea or theme. Using the Curatorial Projects Exhibition Idea Sheet write down two possible ideas for an exhibition using the format of a Title and Thesis Statement

Think of a basic topic that would work for all periods of art. It could be about anything that interests you. It could be political, social, or even purely visual. For example how have artists used a particular color?

Your exhibition will include at least 10 images by 10 different artists. Your images must be from major museums by recognized masters.

Your presentation will include one slide from each the following categories:

Non-western

Female

Modern

Contemporary

Prior to 1860

Ancient (may be anonymous)

All exhibitions must be fine art based. You can include:

Painting, drawing, sculpture, installation, conceptual art, earth art, light art, video art stills, murals, sight specific art, or photography.

No tattoo art, illustrations, cartoons, anime, or graffiti art.
