4. Read pages 407-409 in your textbook to learn about comparison and contrast essays.

5. **Streamline your essay.** That means if you are focusing on the differences, begin briefly with the similarities or visa versa. For example, your thesis statement should be similar to: "Although Shirky and Carr are both educators who are concerned about the use of the Internet to enlighten future generations, the authors differ in their beliefs about the Internet's usage, effectiveness, and accuracy." Something to that effect. That way you will only have to focus on what is more prevalent rather than a pure comparison and contrast essay where you have to devote the first half of your essay to the comparison (similarities) and the second half to your contrasts (dissimilarities).
