Hence, workers cannot afford the expensive rent in the city, so seven or ten workers are forced to share one small room with no privacy at all. There are even many couples who leave their children in the countryside. These couples come to work together at Foxconn and would rather not have a big meal every month to save as much money as possible for their children and their parents back home.

Because of the exploitation by capitalists, there are also workers who cannot afford to commit suicide. A lot of workers have decided to go on strike because they had been oppressed for too long, but it has done little more than raise wages a little bit. The factory built a lot of fences to keep workers from jumping off buildings to suicide. As Marx says in The Communist Manifesto, "Oppressor and oppressed stood in constant opposition to one another, carried on an uninterrupted, now hidden, now open fight, a fight that each time ended, either in a revolutionary reconstitution of society at large, or in the common ruin of the contending classes" (65). The oppressor and the oppressed are almost in a struggle because of the disunity of money and power.
