Leaders,

Develop an analytical essay using the seven principles of mission command to appraise and compare the Operation Anaconda Case Study, March 2002. Use your time to develop a deep understanding of your topic to fully explain your analysis.

Construct the essay IAW the American Psychological Association (APA) Writing Style. Your essay should include four major sections: a Title page, an Abstract which is an in-depth introduction of your topic, Main Body consisting of 3 full pages and no more than 5 pages, and a Reference page with at least one additional source for the bibliography. **The affiliation for each author and the author's note is NOT required.**

Your essay will be typed, double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11") with 1" margins on all sides. Use 12 pt. Times Roman font.

To create a page header/running head, insert page numbers flush right. Then type "TITLE OF YOUR PAPER" in the header flush left using all capital letters. The running head is a shortened version of your paper's title and cannot exceed 50 characters including spacing and punctuation.
