- **Week 7**
 - Think about how the information you found in your research informs their task of applying the case study (inspirations or cautionary information) to the local population
 - Brainstorm at least five ideas and possible solutions.
- **Week 8**
 - Think about your five solutions. Choose one as the project idea.
 - Sketch out an idea for prototyping the solution.
- **Week 9**
 - Consider these questions as you work on your project:
 - What additional information do I need?
 - How will I find that information?
 - How will I create my presentation?
 - Work on the project
- **Weeks 10, 11, 12**
 - Continue working on the project and finalize it.
 - Post project to the LMS as a video file or as a link to YouTube by the last day of Week 12.

Individual Student Responsibilities

- **Task 1: Course Project** (see above)
- **Task 2: Peer Feedback.** View all other students' projects. Post feedback (using the specified prompts) on at least two peers' work, one per week.
- **Task 3: Project Journal.** Complete a weekly entry in the project journal, responding to the questions posed by the instructor. Written or video responses are acceptable, so long as they include thorough and thoughtful answers. Journals are private – only the student and the instructor will read these entries. You will post one entry in each of Weeks 5-14. Criteria for responses will be embedded in the weekly prompt.
