CROSS-CULTURAL HEALTH PERSPECTIVES AND HEALTH CARE FRONTLINE WORKERS

In a 6- to 8-slide PowerPoint presentation, complete with speaker's notes, continue the work that will result in your finished presentation for the Board of Directors.

In this module's presentation, discuss policy and procedures needed to inform patients and families regarding the facility's cultural standards. Explain why these policies and procedures are important, both during and outside of a pandemic. Identify methods of including frontline HCWs in the development of procedures in the facility and rationalize how it would be beneficial.

Note: At this point, your PowerPoint should be at least 12-16 slides, not including your title or reference slides. You should have 4-6 references as well.

1. Conduct additional research to gather sufficient information to justify/support your strategic plan.
2. Limit your response to a maximum of 8 slides (title and reference slides are not included in page number count).
3. Support your report with peer-reviewed articles, using at least 2-3 references.
