

- Discuss your strategy for identifying key data points, including the type of data you gather and where you will look to find this data.
- Determine the best way to present this data, considering data visualization tools we examined in Week 2.
- Summarize how you would go about creating a quality control proposal for this company. What are some of the key points you would consider for quality control?

### The Analyzing Quality Data paper

- Must be two to three double-spaced pages in length (not including title and references pages) and formatted according to **APA Style** (<https://writingcenter.uagc.edu/apa-style>) as outlined in the Writing Center's **APA Formatting for Microsoft Word** (<https://writingcenter.uagc.edu/apa-formatting-microsoft-word>) resource.
- Must include a separate title page with the following:
  - Title of paper in bold font
    - Space should appear between the title and the rest of the information on the title page.
  - Student's name
  - Name of institution (University of Arizona Global Campus)
  - Course name and number
  - Instructor's name
  - Due date
- Must utilize academic voice. See the **Academic Voice** (<https://writingcenter.uagc.edu/academic-voice>) resource for additional guidance.
- Must include an introduction and conclusion paragraph. Your introduction paragraph needs to end with a clear thesis statement that indicates the purpose of your paper.
  - For assistance on writing **Introductions & Conclusions** (<https://writingcenter.uagc.edu/introductions-conclusions>) as well as **Writing a Thesis Statement** (<https://writingcenter.uagc.edu/writing-a-thesis>), refer to the Writing Center resources.
- Must use at least one scholarly, peer-reviewed, or credible source in addition to the course text.
  - The **Scholarly, Peer-Reviewed, and Other Credible Sources** (<https://content.bridgpointeducation.com/curriculum/file/e5359309-7d3c-4a21-a410-44d59303ccef/1/Scholarly%20Peer-Reviewed%20and%20Other%20Credible%20Sources.pdf>) table offers additional guidance on appropriate source types.
