

ASSIGNMENT #4

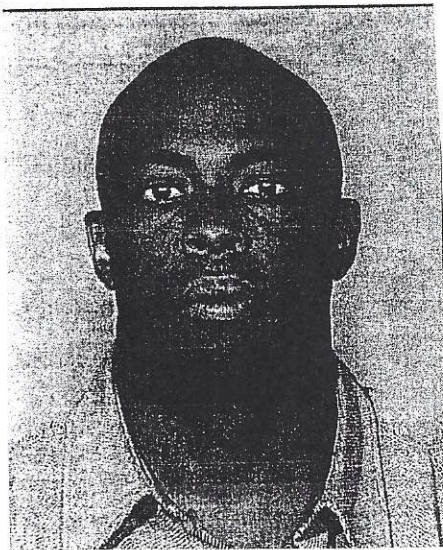
No one in the neighborhood identifies a suspect based on the wanted sketch that was distributed locally.

Two police officers, however, contact the lead detective. Each contends that he recognizes the person in the sketch.

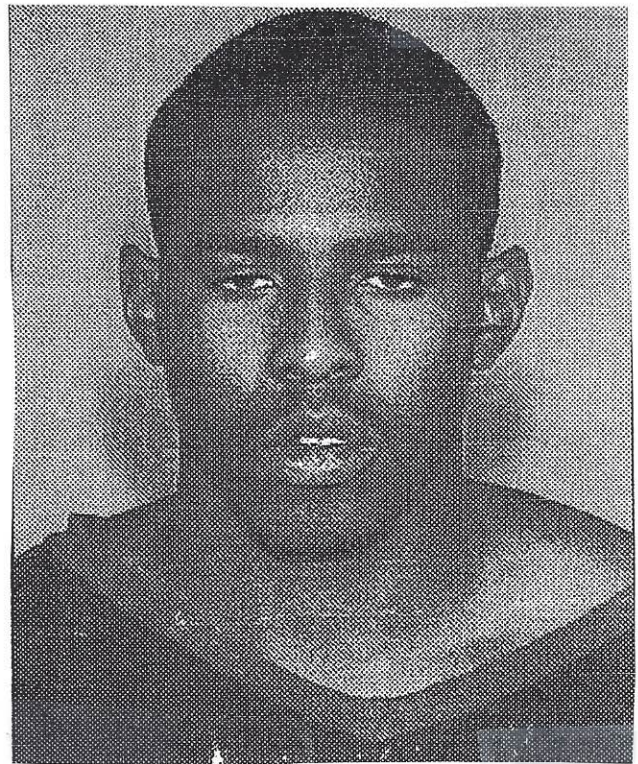

The second officer claims that the individual is Terry Randolph. The officer stopped Randolph in the neighborhood a week before the shooting. He frisked Randolph but found nothing. Randolph lives in the neighborhood near the shooting. He was recently paroled from prison for a grand larceny conviction. Randolph has no prior criminal history of violence or weapons possession. Randolph is 39 years old. He is 5 foot 8 inches tall and weighs 215 pounds.
