Imagery Essay Writing Prompt and Topics

Write an essay of 750-800 words on **ONE** of the following topics:

1. Focusing on Pablo Neruda's "Every Day You Play" (pp. 772-773), discuss how the poet uses imagery. Make references to the five senses as well as the kinetic or kinesthetic.
2. Analyze the use of imagery in Miklos Radnoti's "Forced March" (pg. 775). Explain what the theme of the poem might be.
3. Denise Levertov uses imagery to explore memory and her telescopic vision from the present to explore "A Time Past" (pp. 768-769). Explain how she uses imagery and what kinds of imagery she focuses on.
4. Explain the theme of James Tate's "Dream On" (pp. 778-779). Discuss how he uses imagery to appeal to the readers' senses and emotions.

Turn in your writing process, which will be given a separate grade.

Use the MLA format for in-text paraphrasing and quoting.

Put the Word Count on the right at the bottom of the last page of the essay.

Review the rubric from the course's syllabus and aim for accuracy of elements to earn a passing score.
