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1 As a physician, I keenly observed ethical issues such as the patient's protection from treatment's side effects and welfare. For instance, I made the patient aware of all the options accessible, including their side effects, to make an informed decision. Decision #2 I chose to explain that priapism is one of Trazodone's side effects that would diminish over time. Antidepressants, particularly Trazodone, can facilitate painful persisting penile erection through interference with the sympathetic penile detumescence control (Culnan et al., 20019). In this case, the patient experiences a lengthy erection of the penis after waking, which bothers him. 1 He prefers a change in medication to a drug that does not cause the penis erection. However, the patient admitted that the medication works well. Hence, he was to continue with the dose. 1 I did not choose the other two alternatives since they have significant side effects on the patient. 3 Discontinuing Trazodone can make the patient experience withdrawal symptoms, including agitation, anxiety, or difficulty staying or falling asleep. Switching to Suvorexant can also result in rebound insomnia triggered by dis-
