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reduce the drug's effectiveness, making the patient experience insomnia. **1** These side effects make the medication unfavorable for the patient. By informing the patient about priapism, I expected him to be comfortable taking Trazodone and prevent discontinuation. Additionally, by continuing Trazodone medication, there is the expectation that insomnia can reduce within two weeks (Yi et al., 2018). I also had hope that priapism would diminish over time. **1** As an ethical consideration, the client's progress and health condition were only shared with parties to which the patient consented.

I also advised the patient to monitor his progress to ensure he notices and report any additional side effects.

Decision #3 I chose the decision for the patient to continue with the dose. **1** The medication already demonstrated significant progress with very few side effects. For instance, the patient is only experiencing excessive somnolence. In this case, I clarified to the patient that he could split the tablet in half. **4** Studies show that lower
