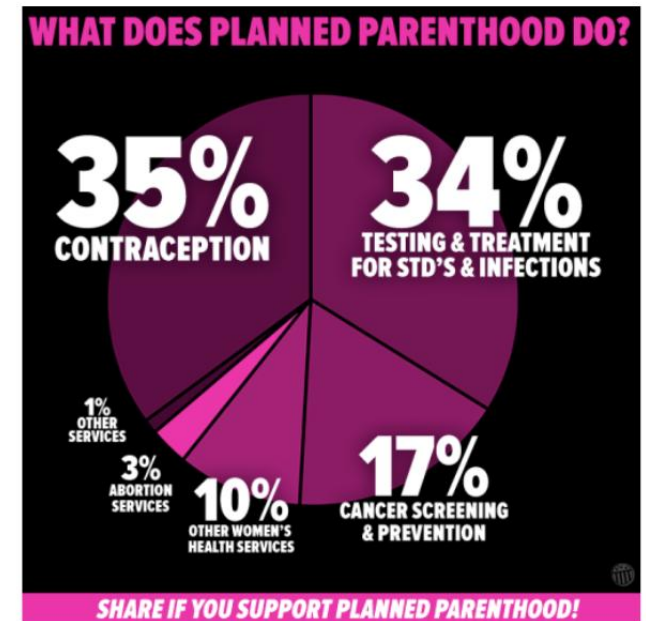

What is planned parenthood?

- A federally funded nonprofit organization
- Provides reproductive health care in the United States. Its services include:
 - providing birth control and other contraceptive methods (35%)
 - providing clinical breast examinations
 - cervical cancer screenings (17%)
 - Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases.(34%)
 - LGBT services
 - Vasectomies
 - Abortions (3%)
 - pregnancy testing and counseling



Importance Of Planned Parenthood

- 1/3 of females have trouble affording prescription birth control
- Provides services to low income citizens
- Helps to fight Health disparities

One in five women in the U.S. has visited a Planned Parenthood health center at least once in her life for a wide range of services.

Planned Parenthood's History



- In October of 1916 Margaret Sanger opened the first Birth Control Clinic in the United States which later became known as the American Birth Control League and then The Planned Parenthood Federation of America.
 - Some challenges they faced:
 - Comstock Act- made the dissemination of birth control illegal.
 - Women's rights were very limited.
 - Religious views forbid any use of contraceptives.
- Although the political climate was very against Planned parenthood, women's suffrage and the fight for birth control rights went on.
- Presently, the Trump administration's efforts to shift federal health programs in a conservative direction have resulted in a new rule being created that prohibits Title X doctors from referring women to planned parenthood abortion clinics and from mentioning abortion as a birth control option.

- Allow women easy access to health care services

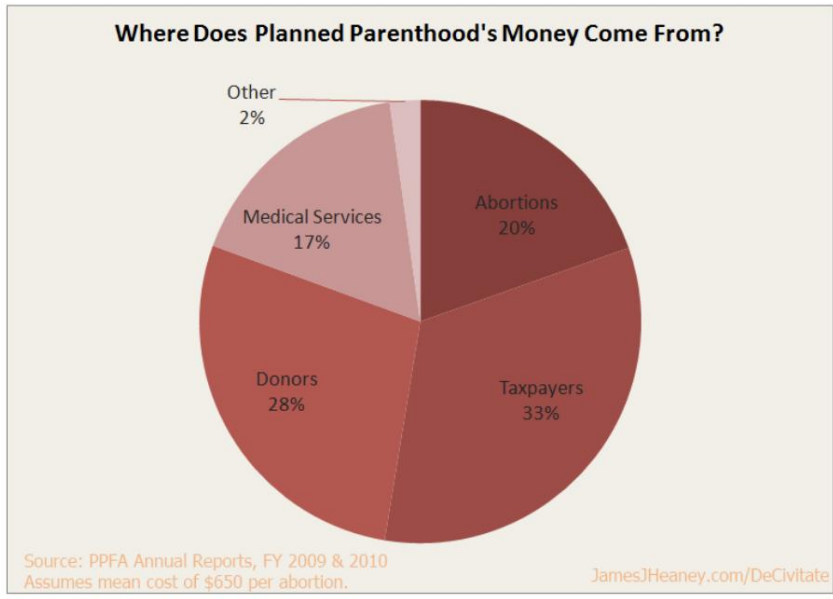

in more than 20% of the counties where Planned Parenthood health centers operate, there are no other health care providers who serve patients who rely on safety-net providers.

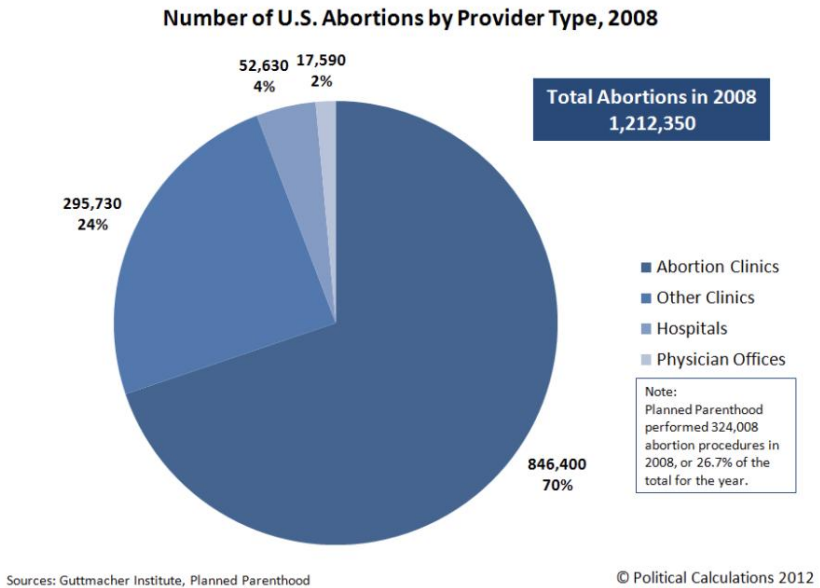
The Drawbacks of Federal Funding

- The pro-life community spends their tax money towards Planned Parenthood, a cause that violates their morality.
- Planned Parenthood emphasizes abortions instead of preventative care.
 - They made **1,880 adoption referrals** and just **18,684 prenatal services** last year, but they performed **327,653 abortions**.
 - Even cancer screenings at planned Parenthood have decreased **50%** since **2004**.
- Planned Parenthood stands accused of jeopardizing the safety and health of women and girls.





Taxpayers are paying the largest portion towards Planned Parenthood, even those against it.



People depend on abortion clinics, like Planned Parenthood, if they are in need of an abortion.

To Sum Things Up...

- Easier access to health service
- Provide women a safe environment
- Defunding would have negative economic effects
