Data quality Your project should be based on an extensive, open-ended interview that was tailored to the particular individual and their experience. Specific details throughout the project should reflect the depth and richness of the information you collected.		10 pts
Narrative content The final project should present a cohesive account of the experiences being described. The temporal sequence of events and the actors and institutions involved should be clear.		10 pts
Analysis of personal experience The project should not simply present a chronological account of events, but should also include a discussion of how the experiences affect identity and social worlds. What is the significance of this experience in the everyday life of your interviewee?		20 pts
Analysis of sociocultural context The project should also place the experience within a broader social or cultural context. How did this context affect the series of events or the individual's personal experiences?		20 pts
Effective use of medium While there are a variety of ways to present your final project, the medium you chose (written paper, graphic illustrations, audio, video, etc.) should support your analysis. The project should be clearly organized and easy to follow, and the flow of ideas should be logical and consistent. Effective communication techniques should be evident. Written narratives and graphic images should be clear and easy to interpret; audio or visual narration should be smooth and clearly enunciated; music or sound effects should enhance understanding of the presentation. All materials (including images, music, and sounds) must be used in compliance with copyright law, and outside sources should be credited appropriately in either text or accompanying notes.		10 pts
