Effectiveness InTASC10	Project includes all material needed to gain a comfortable understanding of the topic. (10 pts.) Sequencing of Information	Information is organized in a clear, logical way. It is easy to anticipate the type of material that might be on the next slide. (10 pts.) Presentation shows an attempt at originality and inventiveness on 1-2 slides. (7 pts.) Spelling and Grammar	Presentation has no misspellings or grammatical errors. (5 pts.)	Presentation has 1-2 misspellings, but no grammatical errors. (4.25 pts.) Use of Graphics	All graphics are attractive (size and colors) and support the theme/content of the presentation. (5 pts.)	A few graphics are not attractive but all support the theme/content of the presentation. (4.25 pts.)	All graphics are attractive but a few do not seem to support the theme/content of the presentation. (3.5 pts.)	Several graphics are unattractive AND detract from the content of the presentation. (2.75 pts.)
Organization	PowerPoint contains a minimum of 10 slides. All parts of the task are completed fully and support the theme/content of the presentation. (5 pts.)	PowerPoint contains a minimum of 10 slides. All parts of the task are completed partially and support the theme/content of the presentation. (4.25 pts.)	PowerPoint contains fewer than 10 slides, or some slides designed do not support the theme/content of the presentation. (3.5 pts.)	PowerPoint contains fewer than 10 slides and is missing several parts of the task. Slides designed do not support the theme/content of the presentation. (2.75 pts.)
Sources	All sources (information and graphics) are accurately documented in the desired format. (5 pts.)	All sources (information and graphics) are accurately documented, but one is not in the desired format. (4.25 pts.)	All sources (information and graphics) are accurately documented, but two or more are not in the desired format. (3.5 pts.)	Some sources are not accurately documented. (2.75 pts.)
