

In preparation for your final project, you will assert a thesis in your seventh posting regarding *Never Let Me Go* that you will support by analyzing evidence, including at least one quotation from the **second third of the novel** one quotation or point from a scholarly journal article that you select on your own. Your response can continue along similar lines as those you explored in Posting 6, addressing different examples.

You will respond to one of the following questions:

- 1.) How is *Never Let Me Go* relevant in today's world? What in them should readers know about? What in the text allows us to better understand our world and what light does our world shed on that of the text?
- 2.) What is the role of power in *Never Let Me Go*? How is it similar to or differ from the ways we have seen power function in at least one other text we have read this term? Why is this similarity or difference significant?
- 3.) How does *Never Let Me Go* allow us to better understand technology, art, or the intersection of the two? What does it teach us?
