

Grading Criteria

LEX6051: Rank Ordering Six Evidence-Based Practices for Intensifying Instruction

Everyone starts with the full 100 points for this assignment. I will deduct partial (e.g., 0.25 points) or full points (e.g., 1, 2, or more points) for substandard performance in the following areas.

Content - Points will be deducted for not directly and substantively addressing a required item.

Grammar - Points will be deducted for improper spelling, punctuation, capitalization, or syntax (i.e., word order) and inadequate articulation of the ideas/content presented.

Formatting - Points will be deducted for failing to follow the formatting guidelines I have established for the paper or a total disregard for these guidelines. This includes the required length for the paper.

Miscellaneous - This category is intended to award extra credit for an exceptionally well-done assignment. However, I reserve the right to refer to it to deduct points for something I did not anticipate.
