Many argue that Beowulf is a loyal character. After all, he went to fight for Hrothgar's kingdom in an effort to repay a favor to his own father. Do you believe in loyalty? Does loyalty still exist today? How far would you go or have you gone in your loyalties to someone?

Write a 3-paragraph response in which you address the question of loyalty. In each paragraph, you must follow the C-E-A format (Claim-Evidence -Analysis).

Claim	The writer's position on the topic. The writer provides an answer to the assigned question based on his/her understanding.
Evidence	The proof or evidence that supports the claim. This evidence would be in the form of direct quotes and supporting details from the piece of literature (story, poem, novel, play). Possible sentence starters: One example from the text... As shown in this passage...
Analysis	The writer's explanation how the evidence supports the position or claim. Possible sentence starters: Based on the above evidence...

Paragraph 1:

Describe your idea of loyalty. What does it mean to you?

Paragraph 2:

Describe a time when you have been loyal to someone or they have been loyal to you.

Paragraph 3:

Make a connection to Beowulf. How are your ideas and experiences with loyalty similar or different to that of Beowulf's.
