Research Paper Requirements for Introduction to Juvenile Delinquency

The paper will concern a topic covered in the course and will be chosen by the student (a place to start is the lecture notes and the tables of contents in the books).

The topic must be approved in order to ensure it is neither too broad nor too narrow. You may change topics at any time, but your new topic must also be approved.

No one may choose a topic already taken by someone else, without prior approval.

The paper must be a minimum of six pages in length (excluding cover page, bibliography, etc.) double spaced. Fonts shall be 12, standard margins, and do not skip lines between paragraphs and heading.

A minimum of six scholarly sources is required. . Do not

use class books, encyclopedias, dictionaries, comic books, or any of the numerous unscholarly sources mentioned in class.

Proper citation of sources is quite important. When borrowing someone else's thoughts, idea, data and the like, you must give proper credit. Be sure to follow directions for this crucial element of you paper.

The use of quotations is frowned upon. Paraphrase. Block quotes are to be especially sparingly, since they inflate the length of the paper.



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
