# Multi-Genre Project

Due: Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup>

The multi-genre project is our final project for the year.

You are going to choose a theme, idea, or topic and explore it through three pieces of work that are all different genres.

## Here's what you will do:

**Step 1:** Decide on a theme or topic you might want to explore with this project.

**Step 2:** Decide which three pieces you will create.

**Step 3:** Write your pieces.

**Step 4:** Create "glue" to hold it together. The glue can be anything from quotes to song lyrics to definitions. The purpose of the glue is to connect each of your genre pieces to your overall topic and purpose.

**Step 5:** Write a "Dear Reader" letter that discusses your vision to your readers.

**Step 6:** Put it all together to display as either a poster or a PowerPoint.

You need to pick one from three different categories. So for example, one from narrative, one from visual, and one from other.
