2. Export the dashboard image as a .png file with the file name MiniProjectIII_Dashboard_GlobalID and submit it to Blackboard.
3. Save the Tableau file as a .twbx file with the file name MiniProjectIII_Dashboard_GlobalID and submit it to Blackboard.

Bonus task:

1. Create a story using the visualizations you created in the previous week. There should be at least three story points in this story. Each story point should have a brief description/analysis of the data visuals accordingly.
2. Export this story to PowerPoint with the file name MiniProjectIII_Story_GlobalID and submit it to Blackboard.
