

## **Mental Health Assignment (Teaching Project)**

Assignment:

You will be assigned a mental health condition for research. You will watch the assigned movie that the actor(s) will portray of your assigned mental health condition. You will be asked to write a response based on the film. A rubric will be provided for guidance. The objective of this assignment is to research your specific mental health condition and create an awareness of what the signs and symptoms look like and how the condition is treated.

Attached you will find the template for a pathophysiology map and medication cards. You will need to create a pathophysiological map and medication cards for your mental health condition. Medications will be based on medications that are normally used to treat the condition. Choose 3-4 medications to complete cards for. You will research what medications are used for your mental health condition. Choose 3-4 medications to complete medications on.

You will create your pathophysiology map of your mental health condition, watch the assigned film, write your essay response, complete patho map, and medication cards. You will research and create your medication cards, these will need to be handwritten (research shows that if you write them out it creates more of a memory of the information).

Essay: Needs to be 3-5 pages in length, minimum of 600 words. Your essay will be designed to answer the questions from the rubric completely. Paper will be double spaced and you may organize based on sections of the rubric. Font needs to be 12 pt font, APA format with a reference list. You must have a title page, pages to be numbered. Must include 3 or more references that are appropriate sources such as textbooks, in class lectures, psychological websites, medical journals, etc. You may not use any artificial intelligence resources for this paper.
