5-2 Final Project Milestone One: Introduction to the Clinical Microsystem (6 pages)

Instructions

For Milestone One, you will introduce and evaluate a clinical microsystem and a chronic disease that a client in this microsystem would be managing. In doing so, you will examine key leadership positions in the microsystem, the interrelationship between the microsystem and the meso- and macro-systems, and the county, state, and federal regulations that affect the facility and the patients. Furthermore, you will identify the barriers that these clients may encounter when managing their chronic disease.

Note: The content of this milestone aligns with Sections I, II, and III of the final project.

7-2 Final Project Milestone Two: Healthcare Leadership Presentation (6 pages)

Instructions

For Milestone Two, you will develop a presentation for the clinical leadership team in the microsystem you introduced in Milestone One. This presentation should be developed from the perspective of your role in the healthcare facility. Your presentation must include an introduction to provide a brief overview of the microsystem, including the barriers clients encounter. Note that this introduction will be a summary of what you completed for Milestone One and should incorporate any instructor feedback you received.

Furthermore, you will present solutions to the barriers you identified in the previous

milestone and recommend one health-promotion activity and one leadership style to improve client outcomes within your microsystem. You will also develop a plan to evaluate the effectiveness of each recommendation.

The information you prepare in your presentation will be developed into a paper for your final project submission in Module Nine. (Specifically, the milestone content aligns with Sections IV, V, and VI of the final project.) Be sure to carefully review the critical element for the milestone. This will ensure that you have addressed each requirement so you can receive feedback from your instructor.

IHP 505 Milestone One Guidelines and Rubric

(6 pages)

Overview: For your final project, you will examine a microsystem from the perspective of your current or future role in healthcare. In order to explore the microsystem, you will select a chronic disease that a fictional client might face at your selected clinical facility. (This could be the facility where you currently work or the type of facility where you intend to work after graduation, related to your area of study.)

For Milestone One, you will introduce and evaluate a clinical microsystem and a chronic disease that a client in this microsystem would be managing. In doing so, you will examine key leadership positions in the microsystem, the interrelationship between the microsystem and the meso- and macrosystems, and the county, state, and federal regulations that affect the facility and the patients. Furthermore, you will identify the barriers that these clients may encounter when managing their chronic disease.

Prompt: Introduce your area of study from the perspective of your role in a healthcare facility, including an overview of the microsystem and barriers clients encounter when managing their chronic disease.

Specifically, the following **critical elements** must be addressed:

- I. **Introduction:** In this section of your paper, you will summarize your area of study and examine how your role in the healthcare delivery system interacts in different microsystems.
 - A. Describe your **major of study** and the role you currently fill or intend to fill related to that area, including how this role fits within the overall healthcare delivery system.
 - B. Summarize the **chronic disease** you selected, including the pathophysiology of the disease, the signs and symptoms, the diagnostic tests, and current evidence-based treatment.
- II. **Microsystems:** In this section, you will evaluate microsystems related to your role and the chronic disease selected.
 - A. Describe a **typical visit** to your facility for a client with your chosen disease. Consider these questions: Who would the client interact with at the facility? How would the client be greeted? How and where would the client receive treatment?
 - B. Discuss the **key leadership positions** within the microsystem and the leadership styles being utilized, as they relate to the management of the chronic disease.
 - C. Based on the leadership styles discussed, evaluate the **effectiveness** of these leadership styles within the microsystem. Explain your reasoning.
 - D. Demonstrate how this facility **interrelates** with the meso- and macrosystem. For instance, if you are at a doctor's office, how does the office work with the community (hospital) or other satellite facilities? For the macrosystem, how does the doctor's office interrelate with state and federal offices?
 - E. Demonstrate how county, state, and federal **regulations** affect the facility and quality of patient outcomes.
- III. **Barriers:** In this section, you will identify the barriers clients encounter when managing their chronic disease.
 - A. Identify **common barriers** clients encounter when managing their chronic disease.

- B. Discuss what barriers can and do arise from leadership changes or ineffective leadership within the microsystem.
- C. Discuss what barriers can and do arise from healthcare regulation changes.

Guidelines for Submission: Your paper must be submitted as a 4- to 6-page Microsoft Word document with double spacing, 12-point Times New Roman font, one-inch margins, and at least three sources cited in APA format.
