The purpose of the response papers is to evaluate your understanding of the **basic theory** as presented in class and from the materials. Four films will be played in their entirety and you will write a paper on **three** of the films.

Submitting: Please submit your Response Papers in the following manner:

- + email your papers as a Word document to my email address before midnight on the due date;
- + cc or bcc yourself to confirm delivery;
- + in the subject area of the email, put your course name and number: BSAD 1020, Movie Title, Response Paper #.

Format: Please include a cover page, indicating the name of the movie, due date, your name, your student number, the course name and number, and the number of words contained in the body of your paper. Please use 12-point font and double space. If your paper does not have a cover page stating the required information, you will lose 5% of your mark.

Word Count: The papers should be between 1,500 and 2,500 words – excluding the cover page, citations, and bibliography. Please make sure the word count of your paper is stated at the bottom of your paper. 5% of your mark will be deducted if the main body exceeds 2,500 words or if the word count is not stated.

Content: Note that your papers are referred to as movie response papers and not movie reviews. In your response paper, please have

- a thesis paragraph;
- a short paragraph or two describing the movie;
- a short paragraph or two describing the historical context; and
- a conclusion paragraph or two.
