

****TEACHER NOTES**** One thing that immediately stands out is that you appear to be using APA format instead of MLA format. Please review the MLA how-to that I placed in the Lesson 1 folder. Your essays for this class and the ENGL 1301 class should not use headings, subheadings, or other types of labels for individual paragraphs.

You will also need to include an outline within the document since this assignment is for the DIRW 0493 portion of the course.

Mostly, I would encourage you to add more examples to your essay to help illustrate your points. I would also suggest you reconsider the section on character; your paragraph shows that you consider the character (role) to be the same as the actor, and the standard for discussing creative works of this type is that the role and the actor should **not** be conflated. For example, perhaps one dislikes

the character of Iron Man, but the things Tony Stark does that make someone hate his character are **not** flaws in Robert Downey Junior's personality. It's important to maintain that distinction, just as when we discuss literature, the characters (and possibly the narrator) **do not** necessarily represent the views or ideals the author personally has. An effective and successful author can write from the point of view of a character who is racist without personally having racist views.
