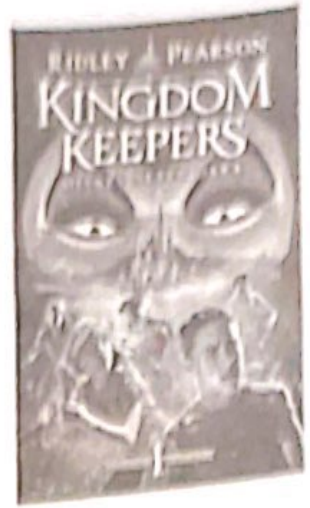


Kingdom Keepers: Disney After Dark
