1. From the sociological standpoint, humans are essentially social beings
2. Unlike sociologist, most people base their knowledge of the world on conventional wisdom, background knowledge, and personal experience.
3. Even though only tiny minorities of people have been academically trained as sociologist, almost everyone could be described as a "natural sociologist" because we are all members of society and so have a great deal of background knowledge about how society works.
4. Sociology is described as the systematic and scientific study of human society and social behavior. That the level of social structure that sociologist might examine is almost any level, from interactions between two people to large scale institutions.
5. Sociology can be best understood as the study of people "doing things together", said Howard Becker that this definition reminds us that neither society nor the individual exist in isolation, each is dependent on the other.
6. Sociologist observes society by studying the various parts of a society, and the ways they interact and influence each other.
7. Doing sociology can be described as a radical undertaking because sociology is about change and creating new social structures.
8. Sociology can be approached either the micro sociological or a macro sociological perspective, both perspectives are useful in different ways, because they each provide different types of information about the same object of study.
