#### NOT EVIDENT

A needs-assessment summary is not provided.

The needs-assessment summary is missing information about the health needs or risks of the virtual community. The summary does not appropriately incorporate each of the required assessment tools.

#### COMPETENT

The needs-assessment summary logically includes the health needs and risks of the virtual community. The summary appropriately incorporates each of the required assessment tools.

### B1:DATA ANALYSIS

#### NOT EVIDENT

An analysis of the collected data is not provided.

#### APPROACHING COMPETENCE

The analysis is missing key information about the concepts of epidemiology and health determinants. The analysis contains irrelevant details about the virtual community.

#### COMPETENT

The analysis appropriately incorporates the concepts of epidemiology and health determinants. The analysis is well-supported with relevant, appropriate details about the virtual community.

### C1:TOP THREE PROBLEMS

#### NOT EVIDENT

A discussion of the top 3 problems for Sentinel City™ is not provided.

### **APPROACHING COMPETENCE**

### **COMPETENT**

The discussion appropriately incorporates community resources relevant to addressing 1 of the problems identified in part C1.

A primary prevention topic is not identified.

**COMPETENT**

The submission includes in-text citations for sources that are properly quoted, paraphrased, or summarized and a reference list that accurately identifies the author, date, title, and source location as available.

**F: PROFESSIONAL COMMUNICATION****NOT EVIDENT**

Content is unstructured, is disjointed, or contains pervasive errors in mechanics, usage, or grammar. Vocabulary or tone is unprofessional or distracts from the topic.

**APPROACHING  
COMPETENCE**

Content is poorly organized, is difficult to follow, or contains errors in mechanics, usage, or grammar that cause confusion. Terminology is misused or ineffective.

**COMPETENT**

Content reflects attention to detail, is organized, and focuses on the main ideas as prescribed in the task or chosen by the candidate. Terminology is pertinent, is used correctly, and effectively conveys the intended meaning. Mechanics, usage, and grammar promote accurate interpretation and understanding.
