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Part 2: Individualized Practicum Learning Objectives

Objective 1: To enhance my clinical decision-making skills that align with advanced nursing practice.

Planned Activities:

- Participate in case studies that seek to advance current nursing practice knowledge after being allowed to make various decisions.
- Seek opportunities to engage with nurse practitioners and then discover their performance in diverse clinical settings.
- Engage in discussions with peers to determine common knowledge about real-life clinical scenarios.

- Take up leadership roles in clinical settings so that there can be term-based interventions.

- Use assessment tools to determine the the exact method of handling patient data and their needs.
- Work with preceptors to discover unique information types needed to improve individual patient preferences.

Mode of Assessment: Direct observation will determine the proficiency in performing healthcare operations.
