projects, that they have offered you a position as the chief information officer (CIO) at the university. This is a newly created position for the university. At present, technology and information systems is overseen by a technology manager who reports to the chief financial officer (CFO). Leadership has acknowledged this existing structure is no longer conducive to maximizing the university's competitive advantage.

You will be presenting to the university board of directors and administration your vision for the newly created position, including the structure, organization and resources needed to advance strategic objectives and ensure long-term success for the university.

Utilize the following guidelines to create your PowerPoint presentation:

- Provide an introduction and agenda for all topics covered during your presentation.
- Develop and present an organizational chart outlining positions, including a reporting structure, functions, and if the position is a new hire or existing.
- Discuss the importance of aligning information systems with the organizational strategy.
- Present the primary purpose of enterprise resource planning systems.
- Propose the components, functions, and benefits of implementing an ERP system at the university.
- Justify advantages or disadvantages to outsourcing the ERP project.
- Explain the purpose of an acceptable use policy (AUP), and briefly describe essential components.
- Synthesize key points from your presentation by explaining how your recommendations will support strategies well into the future.

Your completed PowerPoint presentation should be at least 12 slides in length, which includes your title and reference slides. Utilize the notes section of the slides to augment bullet points with additional information (this is required). Use PowerPoint best practices to create presentation. You are encouraged to be creative.

You must use at least three sources, one of which may be your textbook, to support your slide content. All content must follow APA guidelines, including all sources used, which must be cited and referenced according to APA Style.
