- 2) Make your claim, which is your unique and arguable statement. Then, help us get a general idea of how it works and why that will be beneficial to us (Implications, greater stakes)

Claim — don't stop at analysis — explain what to do with that analysis and why that would be a good thing for your ~~aud~~ audience.
