Important Problem: ① How Gun Violence Influences the Second Amendment Rights Critical Thinking Question Domain of Thinking Intellectual Standard/Element of Thought Fact, Preference, or Judgement

1. ① Do we have a resolution that could solve gun violence without infringing on American legal firearm owners' ② second amendment rights?

The intellectual standard related to this question is precision because it is specifically inquiring about a definite factor. The required solution should be specific. ① It should have a primary characteristic, namely the capacity to eliminate gun violence without infringing on the second amendment rights of American legal firearm owners.

The element of thought associated with the question would be information because the data and facts of the solution that could eliminate gun violence without infringing on the second amendment rights of American legal firearm owners would lead to further political questions about the impact of the amendment on other aspects socio-politically and economically. 2. ① Are there cultural or religious beliefs that could contribute to an individual's perspective on increased gun control versus protecting second amendment rights?

Cultural Many persons in society believe that violence can be eliminated by increasing gun laws and that eliminating guns will lower the propensity for violence altogether. The intellectual standard related to this question is clarity because to understand and judge the increased gun control versus protecting second amendment rights debate effectively, one also needs to understand the specific connection between each of them and all the sociocultural aspects of the life of which cultural and religious beliefs are key components.

The element of thought involved in this question would be information because knowhow about the relationship between cultural and religious beliefs and gun violence and the second amendment rights would lead to an understanding of how the former influences the latter and their debates. Judgment

3. ① What factors could contribute to an individual's view on gun control versus the protection of the second amendment rights Debate?

Psychological The media plays a huge role in contributing to public opinion. Society is flooded with ideas over so many different media avenues. When gun violence saturates television, internet, and radio it will be impactful but may not necessarily be truthful or unbiased, which can skew perception.

④ The intellectual standard related to this question is clear. To understand and acknowledge people's stances and views on gun control versus the protection of the second amendment rights debate, one needs to be specific about the factors behind their points of view.

⑤ The element of thought involved in this question again would be information. To understand the factors, one would need enough accurate info about them and their relationship with gun violence and control and the second amendment rights.
