

17 Corrections Symbols

1. t = [Verb] Tense Error
2. agr = Subject/Verb Agreement Error. The subject is singular, but the verb is plural, or the subject is plural, but the verb is singular.
3. n = Number Error [If it is singular, it should be plural. If it is plural, it should be singular.]
4. wf = Word Form Error [The noun form was used, but the adjective was needed, etc.]
5. sp = Spelling Error
6. c = Capital Letter Needed.
7. p = Punctuation Error [missing or wrong punctuation mark]
8. wc = Word Choice is wrong; a different word would be correct.
9. ps = Parallel Structure Error [This word should be grammatically parallel to another.]
10. art = Article Error [missing or wrong one]
11. prep = Preposition Error [missing or wrong one]
12. cs = Comma Splice [insufficient punctuation between two independent clauses]
13. r-o = Run-On Sentence [no punctuation between two independent clauses]
14. sf = Sentence Fragment [This is not a complete sentence.]
15. ^ = Missing Word [Add the appropriate Word.]
16. \ = Unnecessary Word [Delete this Word.]
17. ¶ = Paragraph [Consider starting a new paragraph here.]
