

Assessment Criteria

Approach, Elicitation and Notations

Have you adequately described your approach to developing requirements, detailed the steps that you took, and why these were appropriate? Have you adequately described the methods of elicitation used for gathering data in the setting of your choice, the advantages and disadvantages of these, and why these methods were chosen in preference to others? Have you understood how to apply appropriate elicitation techniques in a specific context? Have you understood how to combine elicitation techniques appropriately? Have you designed your elicitation techniques appropriately with respect to the context of the study?

Description of Setting

Have you described the artefact at an appropriate level of detail to orient the reader to the problems and issues surrounding its use? Have you provided an adequate description of the subject domain? For example, the layout and location of the artefact. If it is located in a work setting, have you described the relevant organizational activities that surround it (e.g. the working division of responsibilities, and the timing of activities)? If the artefact is located in a domestic setting or in a public space, have you described when it is used and for what purposes?

Analysis

Have you considered the issues and challenges that arise when using the artefact, both for users and other people? Have you been able to adequately present your analysis in the report? For example, have illustrative fragments or transcripts (perhaps 3 or 4) as encountered in the course material been used to illustrate in detail the issues identified in the analysis? Have you been able to adequately warrant your analysis? Have you critically discussed the analysis phase of your study? Have you demonstrated an awareness of the relationship between data capture and data analysis? Have you demonstrated an understanding of any analytic orientation used?

Requirements

Have you developed requirements for the technologically enhanced artefact? Have you shown how the requirements were produced, and how they relate to your analysis? Have you considered requirements relating to collaboration and interaction? Have you considered how your proposed artefact may change the activities and practices of its users?

Requirements Communication

Have you presented your requirements in an appropriate way? Is the presentation of your requirements clear and well-structured? If models are used, are they clear and syntactically correct? Are textual descriptions clear, concise, and easy to read? Have appropriate templates been used? Are the requirements traceable?
