Five or more primary research articles annotated and PDFs included (2 points)	More than five primary articles annotated & PDFs submitted (2 points)	Five primary articles annotated & PDFs submitted (1.75 points)	Fewer than five primary articles were reviewed and/or no articles and/or notecards were submitted or articles were unrelated to the topic (0-1.5 points)
2. Notecard includes all required information (5 points)	Addressed all criteria in the template concisely and completely with no errors (4.75-5 points)	Addressed almost all criteria in the template completely with few errors (3.5-4.5 points)	Did not address all criteria in the template and/or the notecard template was not used. Information is missing and/or all copied from articles. (0-3.25 points)

Cites in the text and uses one-to-one correspondence in the references (i.e., avoiding plagiarism) (1 point)	No more than two errors in the assignment (1 point)	No more than five errors in the assignment (0.75 point)	More than five errors in the assignment or there are incomplete or missing citations, resulting in plagiarism. (This will result in a failing grade for the assignment.)
5. Uses APA (7th ed.) format (i.e., citations & references) but single space & enter data into the "notecard" (1 point)	No more than two errors in the assignment (1 point)	No more than five errors in the assignment (0.75 point)	The assignment does not comply with APA (7th ed.) formatting (0-0.5 points)
