deficiencies can be addressed. Future reviews are then to be conducted to determine if a change in mission is warranted or if there needs to be an internal readjustment of operation.

A review is made of the decided upon or otherwise mandated goals and objectives of entities across the jurisdiction in order to determine the landscape of entities that are working to achieve similar goals. This will allow for the determination of whether there exists necessary or unnecessary redundancy with regard to operations and the allocation unlimited resources.

Organizations will be able to identify specific functions they perform for the betterment of the community and to what degree it would be prudent to establish partnerships in those efforts. It may be discovered that an organization may be better equipped to work on different functions that is to say a reallocation of effort such that one organization does function a, b, and c and another organization does function d and f, all of which are required for the accomplishment of the originally stated goal. This may lead to greater efficiency and effectiveness again in the service of the community. It also may prove to be useful for the minimization of waste and the misallocation of effort for the jurisdiction.

A comparison can be made between what exists in terms of service provision for a jurisdiction and what is required because collaborative stewardship allows for the
