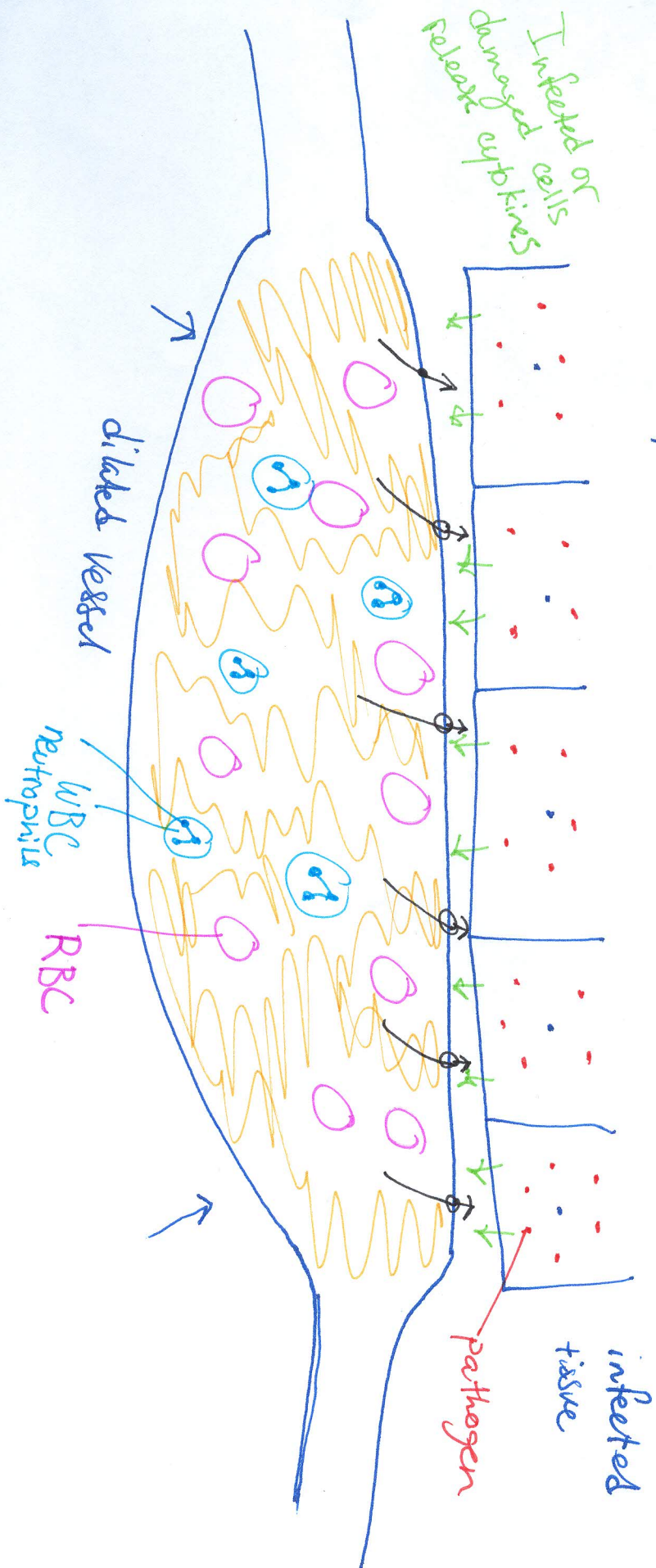


The Two Phases of Acute Inflammation

① Vascular Phase

- trigger vasodilation at the area of infectious damage
- more blood flow to the site @ lower pressure
- more NUTRIENTS + WBCs will be available
- trigger Cytokine release, then capillary permeability is increased
- more fluid to move into tissues - EDEMA!
- ease mobility of WBC to infected tissue



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
