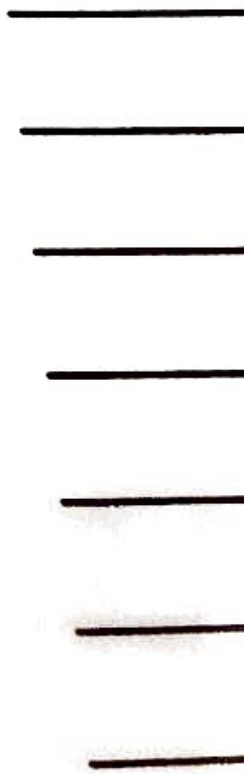

How is a Mastery Measure Different than CBMs?

Mastery Measures	Curriculum-Based Measures (CBMs)
Focus on specific skills taught during the school year	Measure what should be known by the end of the school year
Are administered after a unit or sequence of lessons designed to promote mastery	Are used for monitoring progress toward that end-of-year goal
Are <u>informal</u> and not standardized ✨ ✨	Are standardized, reliable, and valid
Allow scaffolds, supports, and adjustments	Require standard administration and scoring
