She has dressed suitably for the weather, is coherent, focussed, and has clarity of speech. She has good manners but says that her mood is somewhat sad. (6) Mrs Perez does not experience any visual or audio hallucinations or paranoia. Even though she has an impaired impulse, her judgment and insight remain grossly intact. (7) She has no suicidal thoughts or homicidal ideations. (4) Based on the information collected, Mrs Maria Perez's diagnosis is alcohol use and gambling disorder. Decision Point One Mrs Perez will be started on Naltrexone (Vivitrol) injection 380mg intramuscular injection in the gluteal region in the first decision point. The Naltrexone will be administered to the patient in four-week cycles. (6) Naltrexone is efficient in the treatment of patients who have an alcohol addiction. The medication
