The patient must also be made aware of alternative treatment options and why choosing this particular option. This will make sure she gives informed consent for the treatment or asks for an alternative. (4) Decision Point Two It has been four weeks since Mrs Perez first came to the clinic, and the Naltrexone injection was administered in decision point one. Talking to the patient, she says that she is feeling well. (4) She also says that she has not taken any alcohol from the time the injection of the Naltrexone was given. The patient also reports that she no longer gambles as much as she used to.

(6) However, she says that she is still smoking, and it continues to concern her because she knows of the health effects of smoking. (9) She also says that she is experiencing anxiety, and she is worried about it. After considering the feedback from Mrs Perez, the primary focus in this decision point two is to focus on gambling addic-
