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cause it is too soon to discontinue it. Ethical considerations in this decision point include patient confidentiality. Mrs Perez should not be asked to share whatever she discussed with her counselor. Further to that whatever she discusses should be held in confidentiality. She must also give her consent for whatever treatment options are settled on. **6 Conclusion The patient was diagnosed with gambling disorder and alcohol use disorder.** Vivitrol (Naltrexone) was prescribed in decision point one. It is an effective medication in treating alcohol disorders since it takes away the patient's pleasure from taking the alcohol by blocking the opioid receptors. In Mrs Perez's case, it was effective, and by her second visit, she had stopped taking alcohol. Indecision point two counseling was settled on as a treatment option for the gambling disorder since cognitive and behavioral approaches are the recommended options for gambling disorder patients. Despite Mrs Perez's reservations about her counselor, decision point three is encouraged to continue with the counseling sessions. Counseling still presents her with the best chance to deal with the gambling disorder. At-
