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disorder. However, they may have significant side effects that may be detrimental to her. For instance, they increase the danger of irregular heart rhythm, which may be severe and life-threatening. Seroquel can also cause high blood glucose and weight gain. I hoped to have the woman return to her instant post-discharge status when restarting the lithium. Stahl's prescriber's guide argues that lithium treatment aims at complete mania remission, treatment until symptoms subside, or stable improvements when continuing treatment to avoid recurrence (Carvalho et al., 2020). 4

When the patient returned to the clinic four weeks later, there was no patient change from her initial visit. In this case, her noncompliance with taking medication as prescribed led to no change. As an ethical principle, I have to discuss the risk of treatment to the patient as part of informed consent. Decision #2

I chose to address the woman's reasons for noncompliance and educate her on why she should take the medication. The reason is that medication taking is behavioral, and handling non-adherent patients by offering resources and support can result in
