④ I chose to start with Zyprexa 10mg, which is an antipsychotic drug that affects brain chemicals. The patient would take the drug once daily. ⑤ The drug has the approval to treat mental health disorders' symptoms such as schizophrenia and bipolar disorder in adults and children 13 years or above (Schulte-Mecklenbeck et al., 2017). Zyprexa functions by helping to regain neurotransmitters' balance in the brain. ⑤ In this case, Zyprexa helps treat malfunctions, dysfunctional behaviors, distorted interpretations of events and issues. ④ Invega Sustenna could be a good option. Unfortunately, it increases memory loss risk and side effects of swelling, redness, and pain at the injection site, making the patient avoid turning up for appointments. Additionally, the drug results in weight gain, high cholesterol, and muscles spasms that can impair the patient's physical wellbeing due to her current weight. On the other hand, Abilify also could be a nice choice but only for a patient with a good response to oral Abilify. Again, Abilify fails to bind to the D2 recep-
