③ Introduction Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder is a chronic mental disorder that is commonly found in children. Children suffering from the condition have an inability to sustain attention, hyperactivity and impulsive behaviour (Wolrach et al., 2019). The disease mainly affects people in childhood but may also extend to adulthood.

③ The disorder causes issues with self-esteem, academic performance in school and sustaining relationships.
