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age, while others may live with the condition for life, except that they can learn strategies to be successful. The symptoms of the condition include avoiding tasks requiring focused mental focus, forgetfulness, disorganization, difficulty following instructions and lack of attention. Children develop hyperactivity which manifests in the form of fidgeting, constant motion, talking too much, interruptions during conversation and intruding during conversations. The condition has several risk factors such as genetic effects, premature birth, maternal drug use, problems with the nervous system and environmental toxins such as lead (Wolrach et al., 2019). The condition can be prevented by protecting the child from pollutants and toxins exposure, avoiding anything that may affect fetal development and limiting screen time. Treatment of the condition can be done through behaviour therapy and medications (Ahmann et al., 2017). In the case of a young girl with ADHD, the patient presents multiple symptoms of the disorder.
