

* A Motorcycle is cheaper than the car. According to Wes Siler on the web site Ride Apart in the article entitled How To Get Your College Ride – Why Motorcycles Make Sense For College Students; "~~We'll let's assume that, like pretty much every person in this country, you need some form of transportation beyond a bus pass.~~ A motorcycle will cost you less money than a car. Take a brand-new, shiny Honda CBR250R for example. That bike will do everything you need it to (slowly), including cross the country. Financing one runs as cheap as \$85 a month. That's likely less than your phone bill." As Wes Siler said, A motorcycle will cost you nothing, and it will do everything for you.

Use strong verbs

* A motorcycle is cheap on gas. According to Wes Siler, "I used one as my only transportation for a couple weeks a while back and, even running between LA and Orange County and riding all day every day, my weekly fuel bill never topped \$12". That is awesome--\$12 a week. As I told you in my first paragraph I only put \$10 of gas a week. It will not cost you \$30 of gas every three days like the car.

* A Motorcycle is cheap on service. According to Wes Siler, "Compared to any sort of reasonable car, that little Honda (or anything like it) is going to be cheaper to buy, cheaper to service, cheaper to insure and consumables like tires are going to cost far less money too."

*AGAIN, use variety

* A Motorcycle is cheap on insurance. According to Wes Siler, "I just ran an insurance quote for that CBR250R through Progressive for a 20-year old male living where I do in Hollywood: \$214 a year." As I told you it costs me \$25 a month. That is better than 130\$ for a monthly car insurance.

Qualify this — "MANY people are concerned that..."

↳ There are some weaknesses of using a Motorcycle as transportation. Motorcycles are too dangerous (it is not safe). According to Wes Siler, "It actually is. Per miles traveled in 2007, American motorcyclists were 37 times more likely to die in accident than car drivers". For example, when I go out on my motorcycle my mother always warns me to drive safely and get my helmet on. The truth is if a
