The people of America should therefore not only let empathy and short term outrages be the response to this tragedies. There is a dire need for real talks and actions to stop this vice.

LZ Granderson thinks otherwise that gun control cannot be the solution. To him, what should be dug in to the past history of the mass murderers and their motive behind the shooting (Ferrall 162). The cities that have banned gun shops still have people dying from gun-related violence. The deaths from different gun incidents are not the same and therefore addressing it from the same point of view is wrong. Some have legal guns and still end up using for mass

shooting. The incident in the movie theatres are different from those committed in the street and

Factors leading to gun violence should be addressed such as poverty mental illness and failing schools. It is time not to discuss gun control but the cuts to mental illness, health and its impact on services. Public debates and attacks on the National Rifle Association have proven ineffective way to tackle gun violence. Guys spraying the cities with the bullets believe it or not are not the members of NRA (Ferrall 162). As much as we want to tie it to NRA it has nothing to do with Adam Lanzas. What about the many other shootings that have heppened over the past 10 years?

People should actually not be allowed in to public places with guns. Mc Donald's did well by not allowing somebody in to restaurant with a gun for the safety of customers Preventing people from going on to movie theatres with guns should be a thing of the past as it exposes the audience to great dangers. There should be storage places outside the theatres for guns for people entering inside and one can always pick it after the cinemas (Ferrall 162). Schools should also be well protected and it should be a place that is out of bounce for anybody

Scott Heller had issues with the second amendments. Until recently scholars have had little to say about the second amendment. Sanford levinson a law professor at the University of Texas said that "It's a scandal, the extent to which the legal academy has dodged this issue"He wrote an article on the subject in 1989. The whole talk according to him has been dominated by advocacy groups who fight it out in talk shows, and court briefs.

The number of recent activities by the scholars clearly points in a single direction that academician all legal are referring to a standard model emanating from second amendment interpretations. An associate professor at the university of Tennessee Reynolds As part of a set of articles on the Second Amendment and gun control in the next issue of the Tennessee Law Review, he publishes a detailed critical guide to scholarship on the amendment.

The scholarship has not had much effect in the courts. However it cannot be brushed aside, says Cass Sunstein, a constitutional scholar. "This was a frivolous crazy position and it no longer is anymore", says Mr. Sunstein, a law professor at the University of Chicago (Smith and Ross 98). "The historical research has shown there is some complexity there" he exclaimed.
