Men are full Patches in clubs.

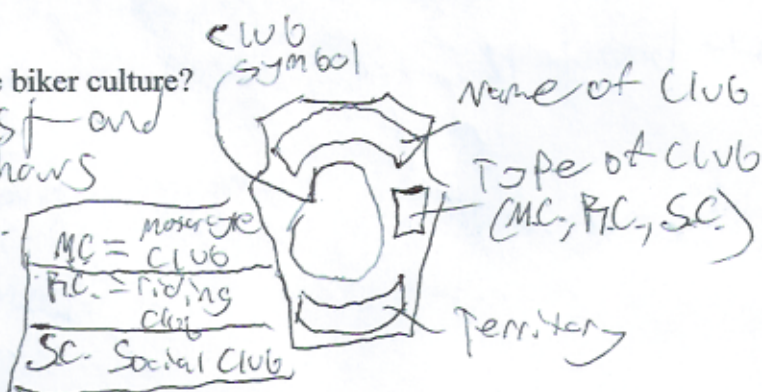
Women are considered "OH-Ladies" Not a member, but looked at as higher than non-club related people in general.
