- 1. Is the hook interesting?**
- 2. Is there a transition from the hook to needed background that places the argument in context?**
- 3. Does the thesis statement contain a focused, clear, credible, and arguable claim (or is the essay merely a report)?**
- 4. Does each body paragraph begin with a topic sentence that expresses a point that supports the claim?**
- 5. Does each sentence in the paragraph relate to the topic sentence?**
- 6. Does each body paragraph contain a source sandwich supporting the point introduced in the topic sentence?**
- 7. Is there an effective transition to the opposition?**
- 8. Is an opposing view introduced in another source sandwich?**
- 9. Is the opposition effectively refuted?**
- 10. Does the conclusion combine a brief summary (not repeating sentences or phrases) followed by reflection, prediction, recommendation or another rhetorical device recognizing the importance of the argument.**
- 11. Are all sources cited properly in-text as well as in a Works Cited list.**
- 12. Are there obvious grammar errors (subj/verb agr, pronoun reference, verb tense, run-on, fragment, comma-splice, etc.)? Just underline grammar errors and advise the writer to go to the Writing Center.**
